Zerach Chan entered a work on paper, "buddha", and won a 1st place ribbon:




as did Anna Smith for her Paper Goat:

When the Steer Judging was delayed and then postponed, Jayden Houston and his steer Smokey kept their cool:




### **Educational Displays**

San Carlos 4-Hers shared their learning with the public by creating information boards.


Asher Becker won Best of Show for his display explaining why there aren't chickens at fair this year:
