
It's Time to Register Again

The guide has four enrollment paths -

- · new youth,
- · returning youth,
- · new adult volunteers.
- returning volunteers



After using 4-H online to register your youth and/or adult volunteers, you'll link to a form to pay enrollment fees for youth and/or adult volunteers (same form, youth info at the top and adults at the bottom). This year the state and county 4-H fees remain at \$80 per youth, and there is a place on the form to request a fee waiver. Our club pays the adult registration fee for volunteers, so please add a comment to that effect on the form and do not pay the adult fee.

It can be a bit confusing, but take your time and you'll get through it! There are two parts to enrollment - enrolling in 4-H online, and paying the registration fee via a survey form.
