Important note: One event should show up ONCE in your record book. For example, if you were a junior judge at Presentation Day and you list it under Leadership Development, do not list also as an Event Attended.

2016 Fair events should already be listed on your 2016 PDR. Events through June 30, 2016 are in last year's book.

1. 4H projects completed this year

-Only count projects that you attended at least 6 hours of project meetings.

2. 4-H Project Skill Activities

- Entered anything in Fair (Every species or type of entry counts as 1 credit. Entered two sheep? counts as 1, entered one lamb and one dress? Counts as 2. Entered cookies and a cake but were not a member of the Cooking Project? Counts as 1 *outside of 4-H* project skill activity) June 2016
- Showed an animal (showmanship) (June 2017)
- Entered cookies in Club Cookie Judging (March 2017)
- Entered something in Life Skills Festival and Field Day. (April 2017)
- Entered anything in any 4-H event related to a project activity
- Entered record book in county or state judging
- Were you judged in something you do outside of 4-H? Piano competition? Math contest? These belong under the *outside of 4-H* section.

- Earned a new Star Rank
- 1st place in any showmanship (June 2017)
- Won a “best in show” (June 2017)
- Rabbit bowl winner (1st place only) (June 2017)
- Avian bowl winner (1st place only) (June 2017)
- Won 1st place in club cookie judging (March 2017)
- 1st place junior judging Club Cookie Judging (March 2017)
