<i>Material and Quantity</i>
<i>Concrete-Related</i>
Concrete, both wet & dry (50 yds)
Rebar # 4, # 5, or # 6.
Concrete formwork materials
<i>Wood products</i>
Retaining wall planks, pressure treated 2"x12"x16'(75) & 4x4's (30)
Plywood sheets 1/2" & 3/4"
2x4's; 2x6's; 4"x4's; 1"x6"x6' fencing boards
Decking pressure treated beams 4x8x20'- 4or5
Decking pressure treated joists 2"x6"x8'or 10'- 30 to 40
Decking materials (wood or plastic)
Deck railing materials
Tar paper
Crushed rock
Cinder blocks
<i>Fencing</i>
Pig pen fencing, gates, etc
Chain link fencing repairs
Chain link fencing gates
New fencing around the south creek side
Animal fencing, 2"x2" welded wire, 4"x4" welded wire, chicken wire, etc.

Electrical wire 12, 14, 16 gauge (different colors), stranded not solid.

Fluorescent lighting 8' fixtures (enclosed, dust rated) 8-10
<i>Landscaping</i>
Railroad ties 20 - 30
Plants, bushes, shrubs (these should be last)

Bobcat (preferably tracked)
Excavator (tracked) 17' reach w/12" dia.x 6' long drill,
